# Block Captain Update

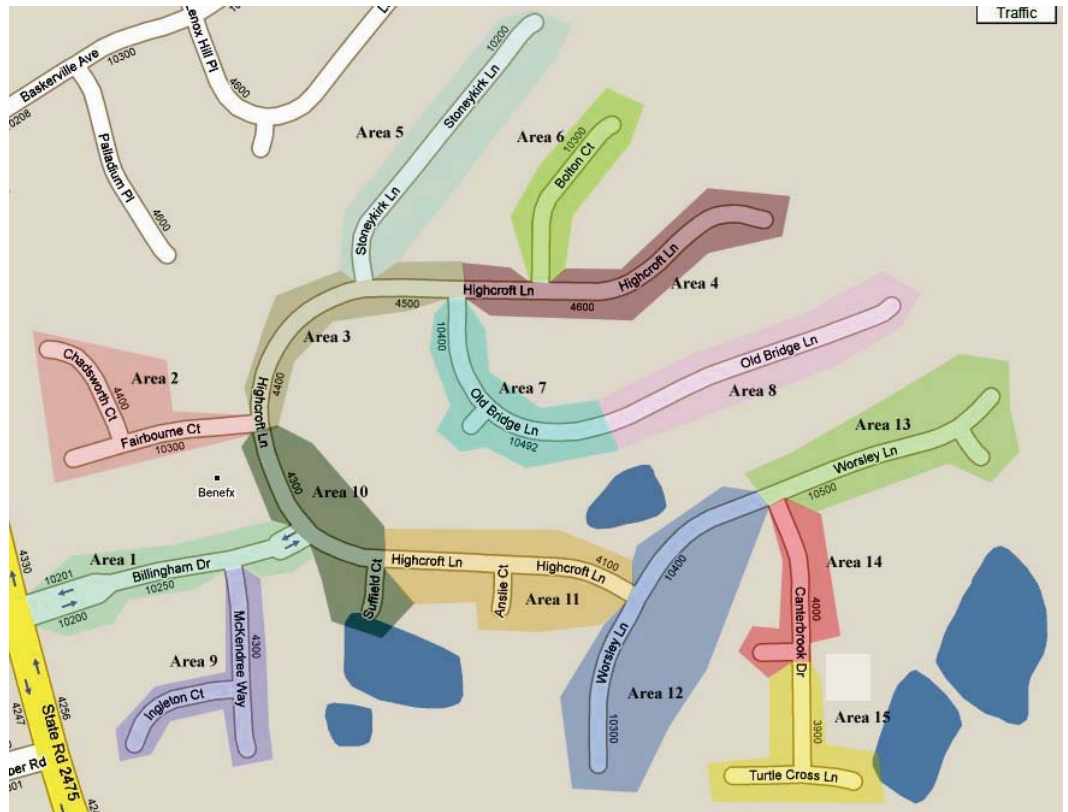
Our block captains have been doing a heck of a job getting *The Villager* distributed each month. As promised, this month we have reprinted the area map, along with the block captain areas and contact info.

Join us at the pool on FRIDAY, July 16 for burgers and dogs and a movie IN THE POOL.

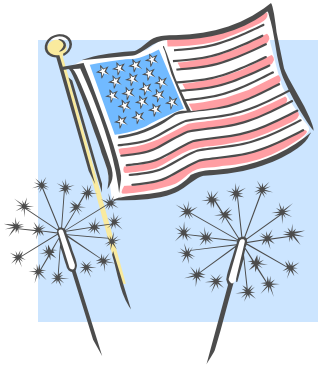
~We will begin serving hamburgers and hot dogs at 6:30 p.m.~
