Do You Have Spring Projects Planned?

If you are planning to make changes or improvements to your property, remember that you must have Architectural Review Committee (ARC) approval prior to the beginning of work.

The following are SOME of the items for which approval is required. <u>This is not a complete listing.</u>

- Exterior painting, including trim and shutters
- Fences
- Major landscape projects
- Outbuildings (cannot be of metal or vinyl construction; see guidelines for approved materials)
- Siding replacement

If you are not sure if your projects needs an ARC review and approval, it is best to submit a request. For additional information, please check the Leacroft Covenants and Restrictions at <u>leacroft.org</u>. The ARC request form also is available at this Web site.

The ARC has 30 days from the receipt of a properly completed ARC request form to return a decision, so be sure to submit your request form at least 30 days prior to the beginning of your project.

A few of the items that the ARC will not approve and which are specifically prohibited are:

- Chain link fences
- Perimeter or privacy fencing greater than 6' high
- Perimter fencing that does not meet guidelines
- Brick mailboxes
- Above-ground pools (exception being kiddie pools)
